How will the data be 'tidied'?

- There will be one record per line in each file
- Fields will be separated by commas
- String fields will be delimited by double quotes
- No comma will be placed at the end of each row in the file
- Records will be terminated by Carriage Return / Line Feed
- Double quotes inside strings will be escaped by doubling
- Outputting a consistent field structure to distinguish property name / number, street, locality, postcode etc
